The Department of Trade and Industry (**the dti**) invites interested companies to participate in an Outward Selling Mission (OSM) to Colombia, from **12 to 16 March 2018**. The objective of the OSM is to facilitate access for South African value-added products and services into Colombia.

Planned activities include Trade and Investment seminar, business-to-business meetings and site visits.

Targeted sectors for trade include capital mining equipment and services, agro-processing and automotive components

Entities that wish to be part of the South African business delegation must:

- have been in business for at least two years
- possess a proven business track record
- be competitive in the South African market
- be export-ready
- have exported previously
- have the capacity to timeously supply any export orders arising out of the visit
- have a valid and current tax clearance certificate.

the dti will offer the following:

- airfare up to a pre-determined maximum amount
- daily subsistence allowance up to a pre-determined maximum amount
- excess luggage for samples to the mission and back to South Africa (up to a pre-determined maximum amount)
- exposure to new export markets
- business-to-business meetings

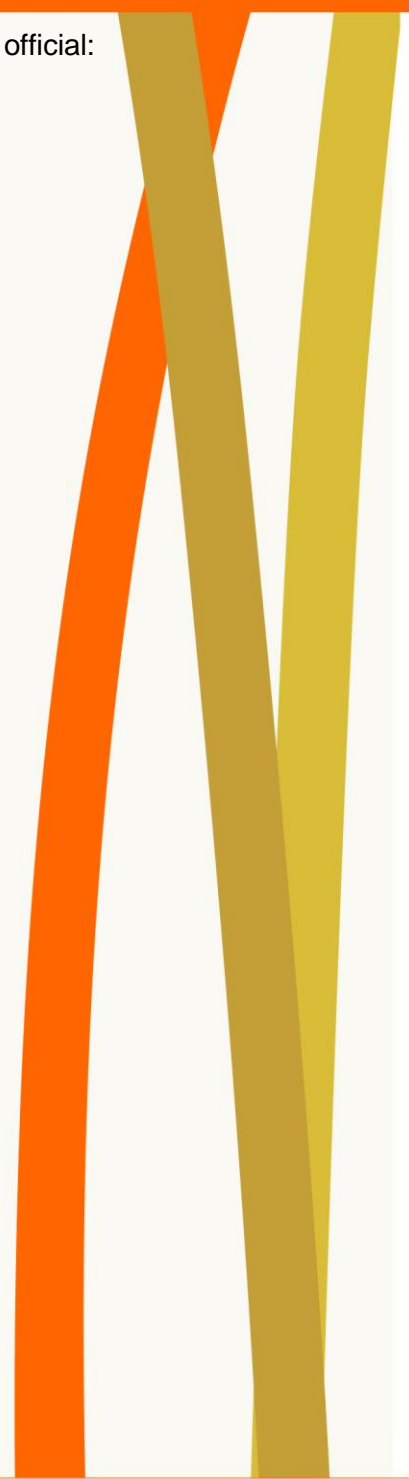
